Please find below a reminder of the KS2 SAT timetable, which will take place next week. They are a statutory part of the curriculum and they will assess the children's understanding in Maths, SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar) and Reading.

Monday 13th May 2024 **GRAMMAR, PUNCTUATION, SPELLING PAPER 1**

SPELLING TEST PAPER 2

Tuesday 14th May 2024 **READING COMPREHENSION TEST**

Wednesday 15th May 2024 **ARITHMETIC TEST PAPER 1**

REASONING PAPER 2

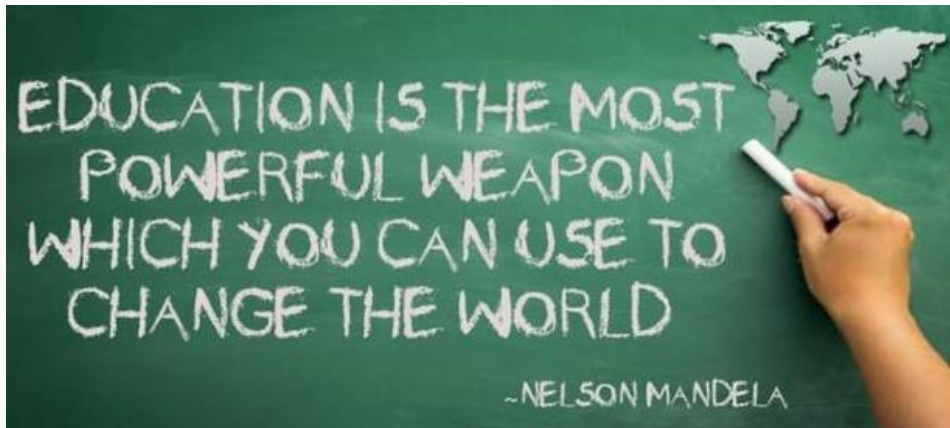
Thursday 16th May 2024 **REASONING PAPER 3**

All papers will take place in the morning therefore attending school on time every day is vitally important.

Should your child miss any test then they will need to be isolated from the rest of the Y6 pupils when they return to school, until they have completed their missed papers. This may mean that pupils, who are absent during these times, will likely complete multiple papers on the same day. These arrangements are a statutory requirement from the standards testing agency to ensure that children do not receive information about test papers that they have not yet seen.

Please do remember that all children have individual access to online revision using the platform SAT Bootcamp and that it is imperative for all children to continue to read daily.
