Dear Parents and Carers of children who are new to our school,



















Week beginning Monday 28st March: children will stay from 8.30am – 11.30am.

















Week beginning Monday 4th April: children will stay from 8.30am – 12.30pm. This will include staying for lunch.

Children attending the **KS2** provision will start on **Monday 28th March**: 8.30am – 2.30pm. All our KS2 children are already in school full time. However, if you feel your child may benefit from additional transition, this can be easily arranged.

Please note: school is closed for our Easter holiday from Friday 8th April until Monday 25th April.

When we return after Easter, <u>all children will be in full time</u>. The Treehouse daily timetable will be 8.30am – 2.30pm.
